

101 OR 999—WHICH ONE SHOULD YOU CALL?

<u>999</u>

- If a crime is occurring now or has just happened
- If you are concerned for someone
- If there is any incident on the motorway
- If you see something suspicious that is happening now or has just happened
- When there is danger to life
- When violence is being used or threatened
- If a suspect of a serious crime is nearby



<u>101</u>

If crime is not in progress or has not just happened—for example a stolen car, burglary or damaged property

- If something is annoying you and is not a crime or you are not concerned for someone's welfare
- Give information to police about crime in your area
- Speak to police about a general enquiry
- Contact a specific Police Officer or member of staff

We understand how upsetting a crime or antisocial incident might be, but please help us to keep the 999 lines free for emergencies.
