	<p>FOMLUC - With some easing of the Coronavirus restrictions there has been an increase in Met. Line frequencies on all branches of the line to about 75% of "normal" but all intending travellers are recommended to check the TfL website for frequencies of ALL the lines they intend to use before setting out on their journey so as to comply with social distancing rules. Capacity per train is reduced to around 13 to 15%; face masks must be used at all times on TfL services. As far as timings are concerned, Uxbridge to Aldgate services and return are running at approx. 15minute intervals, as are Watford to Baker Street services. Chesham and Amersham services are at 30minute intervals - there is an approximate 8minute combined service interval between Harrow on the Hill and Baker Street. Bus routes are running at about 85% of normal timings. As restrictions are further eased timings will change and reference to the TfL website is recommended before setting out on a journey although use of public transport at present should only be for "essential" travel</p>
