Wording of letter to Bank appointing Treasurer as Primary User for Telephone banking approved. 2. Treasurer discussed forecast for this financial year compared to the last 2 years. Does not expect any more income this year due to continued Covid restrictions. 1. Planning Report discussed at meeting.
