#### Dogs out of control in public places

It's an offence to let a dog be dangerously out of control whether that's in public or private.

A dog is considered to be out of control if it:-

- Injures someone
- Makes someone worried that it might injure them

A court could also decide that your dog is dangerously out of control if:-

- It attacks someone's animal
- The owner of an animal thinks they could be injured if they tried to stop your dog attacking their animal.

#### Banned Dogs

In the UK, it's against the law to own certain types of dog. These are the:-



Pit Bull Terrier



Japanese Tosa



Dogo Argentino



Fila Brasileiro

It's also against the law to:-

- Sell a banned dog
- Abandon a banned dog
- Give away a banned dog
- Breed from a banned dog

Whether your dog is a banned type depends on what it looks like, rather than its breed or name.

If you think someone has or is breeding banned dogs, please report it online or if a dog seems to be out of control, call us on 101 in non-emergencies and 999 in emergencies.
