The Eastcote team have maintained their focus on keeping a strong policing presence on the ward and have achieved this by carrying out numerous High visibility cycle and foot patrols targeting crime hotspots for Burglary, Motor vehicle crime, ASB and drugs activity. The team recently took part in the Safer Neighbourhoods Week of Action. The purpose of the Neighbourhoods Week of Action was to police the ward with a strong Multi-agency approach where third party agencies and the community work alongside the police to make the ward a safer place, but to also raise awareness in relation to important topics such as Violence Against Women and Girls and day to day crime that affects the ward such as Burglary, Robbery and ASB. During the Neighbourhoods Week of Action, the Eastcote team worked alongside the South Ruislip team to deliver crime prevention advice and tips to members of the public. The team would like to thank Hillingdon Mayor, Becky Haggar for attending a crime prevention stall at Sainsbury's South Ruislip where the Eastcote team were assisting the South Ruislip team. The Eastcote team also visited Newnham Junior school where they delivered a safety talk to children at the school. PCSO Robinson is delivering Walk & Talk sessions, where women can share their thoughts and experiences on women safety. The team continue to carry out weapon sweeps on the ward and are now holding community weapon sweeps where volunteers can learn and understand what police look for during weapon sweeps.
