The Mayor needs to tackle three key challenges:



Air pollution:

Since the publication of the Mayor's Transport Strategy (MTS) in 2018, significant progress has been made in reducing nitrogen dioxide (NO2) and particulate matter (PM) therefore improving air quality for Londoners.



Climate Emergency:

We are facing a climate emergency: global warming is going to exceed 2°C during this century unless there are deep and rapid reductions in CO2 and other greenhouse gas emissions.




Traffic congestion:

Vehicle congestion cost London £5.1 billion in 2021. Congestion leads to gridlocked traffic as well as increasing air pollution and carbon emissions.

Whilst we've already **achieved a lot**, all London boroughs are still exposed to more PM2.5 and NO2 than the World Health Organisation recommended guidelines

The largest impact on air pollution is from road transport



What is ULEZ and how it operates:



Charges:

- ULEZ operates 24 hours a day,
 7 days a week, every day of the year, except Christmas Day (25 December).
- There is a ULEZ reimbursement for vulnerable NHS patients, for journeys to and from appointments
- New grace periods announced to support over 280,000 disabled people
- The new PCN level is £180

Lorries, vans or specialist heavy vehicles (over 3.5 tonnes) and buses, minibuses and coaches (over 5 tonnes) do not need to pay the ULEZ charge. They will need to pay the LEZ charge if they do not meet the LEZ emissions standard.

A ULEZ expansion will benefit more Londoners

The ULEZ has reduced roadside NO₂ concentrations by **46%** in central London and **21%** in inner London


If no further action is taken to reduce air pollution, around **550,000** Londoners will develop diseases related to poor air quality over the next 30 years. In this case the cumulative cost to the NHS and social care system in London is estimated to be **£10.4** billion by 2050

ALL of London's residents still live in areas that exceed WHO guidelines for air pollution.


Existing grace periods extensions

There will be two-year extensions to the following grace periods to give more time to eligible groups to make the transition to cleaner vehicles

Disabled and disabled passenger tax class vehicles

Wheelchair accessible private hire vehicles

Individuals in this category are exempt from paying the ULEZ charge until **October 2027**







Minibuses used for community transport

Not-for-profit organisations operating community transport minibuses can register with TfL for a 100% discount until **October 2025**







New grace periods

Disabled benefits

- Standard rate mobility component of PIP
- Enhanced rate mobility component of PIP
- Higher rate mobility component of Disability Living Allowance (DLA)
- Enhanced rate mobility component of Adult Disability Payment (ADP)
- Higher rate mobility component of Child Disability Payment
- War Pensioners' Mobility Supplement
- Armed Forces Independence Payment

Wheelchair (and certain adapted vehicle) users

A limited list of other vehicle adaptations aimed at meeting the needs of disabled drivers or passengers will also qualify. These adaptations, listed below, have been identified in consultation with manufacturers and stakeholders representing disabled Londoners:

- A permanent foldable ramp/powered lift
- A electric/Hydraulic hoist
- A swivel seat
- An accelerator ring

This is in addition to all wheelchair accessible vehicles.

Recipients of either these disabled benefits or individuals with a wheelchair accessible vehicle will be eligible for these grace periods from 30 January 2023 until 24 October 2027

NHS Patient Reimbursement Scheme

A patient is **eligible to claim for reimbursement** to and from appointments if they:

are clinically assessed as too ill,
weak or disabled to travel to an
appointment on public transport
and have a compromised
immune system or require
regular therapy, assessment
or recurrent surgical intervention

OR

too vulnerable to infection to travel to an appointment on public transport during an epidemic or pandemic prevalent in Greater London (e.g. COVID-19)

Their treatment must be **provided by or funded by the NHS** and their appointment must be at a site within **Greater London**.

£110m scrappage scheme launched 30 Jan

A large scale and targeted vehicle scrappage scheme to support Londoners, including those on lower incomes, disabled Londoners, charities and micro businesses.



Motorcycles and cars scrappage Grant £1,000 - £2,000



Vans and minibuses scrappage Grant £5,000 - £7,000

Vans and minibuses EV Grant £7,500 - £9,500

Those not using scrappage grants to buy a replacement car or motorcycle will be able to increase the value of their grant by taking advantage of mobility credits and enhanced third party offers.

ULEZ support offers

- As part of the mitigations, we are expanding the number of ULEZ support offers in order to encourage more sustainable travel. These will be separated into:
 - Offers specific to those who receive the scrappage grant
 - Different offers available to the general public who are not eligible for a grant




